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General information

Based on the decision DSW-3-4001-490 / JG / 04 of 19 June 2004. Public University of Humanities, based in Chojnice was registered as a private university with permission to conduct teaching at the undergraduate level (undergraduate) Pedagogy. The next faculties were successively:

Administration – undergraduate ° – DSW-3-WB-4003-121 / 05 of 20 March 2006.

Internal Security – undergraduate ° – MWiSW-DNS-WUN-6022-11837-2 / THAT / 11 of 04 January 2011.

Pedagogy at the Department in Kościerzyna – undergraduate – MWiSW-DWS-WUN-6022-14821-3 / SH / 11 of 01 June 2011.

Pedagogy – Graduate level – MWiSW-DNS-WUN-6022-25094-3-EK / 2012 of 30 November 2012.

English Language Studies- – undergraduate – MWiSW-DSW-weariness-6022-104-2014-EK-1 dated 10 June 2014.

The university educates postgraduate students on specialties connected with the above Faculties in Chojnice, the Department in Kościerzyna and Regional Branches in Grojec, Pionki, Starachowice Kielce, Kazimierza Wielka and Radom.

Within the Faculty of Humanities and Administration were created two departments: Department of Education and Department of Administration.

„Pomerania” allows students and those interested in obtaining additional qualifications and skills through the use of the wide range of courses, training and workshops. On November 9, 2010. The university was entered into the Register of Training Institutions Provincial Labour Office in Gdansk under number 2.22 / 00198/2010.

Since its start , PWSH „Pomerania” employs professional teaching staff of Gdańsk, Sopot, Gdynia, Bydgoszcz, Torun, Olsztyn, Poznan, Szczecin and Chojnice and surrounding areas. Scientific achievements of teachers is documented successively in academic publications such as Acta Pomerania, fields of study beginning with the problems of government, the security issues, the problems of pedagogy, scripts and

others. Chairman of the Scientific Publications PWSH is Rector. Current information about students' life of „Pomerania” illustrates the quarterly publication: Zak Chojnicki.

The University has very active Student Government and Student Scientific Circles such as: Circle of Young Teachers, Students Circle of Administration and Student Scientific Philosophy of Education Circle. Members of the Local Government actively participate in the work of the School's Council, Quality and Education Program, Departmental Committee, Quality of Education and the University Scholarship Committee. They organize cultural and entertainment events (eg. Hazing, meetings Wafer, Pomerania Prom night) and sports facilities (eg. Spring barbecue, canoe) and socially useful (eg. Pre-emptive action blood-Pomerania Children, Christmas Fairs). They engage in work-related organized by the University international conferences, public debates, lectures, etc. Students promote „Pomerania” during the Education Fairs and Labour Fairs in Bytow, Chojnice and Człuchów.

PWSH „Pomerania” provides its students the opportunity to benefit from a wide range of scholarship assistance. Working in collaboration with appointed by the Rector of the Social Council of Employers and the District Labour Office in Chojnice Academic Careers Office, participates among others in projects related to the activation of professional students.

Under the bilateral agreements with external stakeholders, university cooperates in Chojnice with the University of the Third Age, the Primary School Complex No. 1, the Foundation Fuhrmann, Guild of Handicraft, detention center, Shelter for Minors, the Association of Employers of Pomerania, the District Labour Office, Nursery Non-public „Fairy Tale „et al. as well as the Police Headquarters in Warsaw, the Higher School of Economy and Regional Prison Service in Bydgoszcz, the School Czersk and other institutions.

In January and February 2013. Polish Accreditation Commission from Warsaw, conducted in PWSH control of the quality of education in the fields of Administration and Pedagogy. Resolutions No. 542/2013 and No. 543/2013 of 5 September 2013. on the assessment program at the undergraduate level, the Presidium of the SAC issued a positive assessment of the quality of education at both visited directions. Satisfying is the fact that the granting of all the audited evaluation criteria: full.

Graduates of the Universal Higher School of Humanities Pomerania after graduating and knowledge can look for jobs not only in Poland but also in other European Union countries.
